The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Rwanda to the United Nations presents its compliments to the United States Mission to the United Nations and has the honour to communicate the commitments that the Republic of Rwanda will be announcing at the Leaders' Summit on Refugees which will take place tomorrow September 20, 2016.

Examples of new and significant commitments within the Rwandan context could include:

- Public launch of joint MIDIMAR-UNHCR livelihoods strategy, with a focus on graduating camp-based refugees out of assistance programs and increasing formal access to work opportunities.
- Commitment to ensure that 100% of refugees are in possession of valid refugee identity cards issued by the Government of the Republic of Rwanda (NIDA) by the end of 2017.
- Commitment to ensure that 100% of refugee students in secondary school and 50% in primary schools will be integrated into national education system by the end of 2018.
- Commitment to ensure that 100% of urban refugees will have the opportunity to buy into the national health insurance system by the end of 2017.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Rwanda to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the United States Mission to the United Nations the assurance of its highest consideration.
